"A Silver Celebration" will start with an anniversary party at 6:30 p.m. Nov. 27 at Cacharel restaurant, 2221 E. Lamar Blvd.

The special party will include refreshments and both silent and live auctions. Tickets are \$25 per person.

Arlington resident **Karen Borta**, KTVT/Channel 11 news anchor, will serve as event emcee.

The fashion show is worth the price of a ticket alone.

Guests can participate in private shopping, a raffle and a silent auction beginning at 9 a.m.

Tickets are \$75 per person for general seating or \$100 per person for premium seating.

The event will be held from 10 to 11:30 a.m., 1 to 2:30 p.m. or 4 to 5:30 p.m. Tickets are \$20 for a family of four.

Miss Texas **Molly Hazlett** will emcee the show, designed for girls ages 9 to 17.

Gift market hours are noon to 6 p.m. Nov. 30, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Dec. 1 and 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Dec. 2.

Daily admission is \$8 for adults, \$2 for children ages 6 to 12 and senior citizens, and free for children younger than 6.

Special-event tickets include free admission to the gift market.
