JUNIOR LEAGUE OF ARLINGTON SWINGS INTO SPRING WITH “TEE IT UP FOR CHARITY” 2008 GOLF TOURNAMENT

Arlington, Texas (February 23, 2008) - The Junior League of Arlington is hosting its Annual “Tee It Up For Charity” Golf Tournament on Monday, March 31, 2008. This year’s tournament will be proudly held at Shady Valley Golf Club, 4001 West Park Row in Arlington, Texas.

Funds raised from the event will be returned to the community through the projects and services of the Junior League of Arlington. In 2007-08, the Junior League of Arlington will contribute over \$150,000 and approximately 20,000 volunteer hours to the Arlington community.



Registration, lunch and the start of the silent auction begins at 11:30 am. Shotgun start begins at 1 pm. There will be many activities and festivities throughout the day including a putting contest and longest drive contests. There will also be a Chardonnay Club Women’s Golf Clinic to receive personalized training from a golf pro paired with a glass of wine and a ticket to the 19th Hole Dinner award presentation. Following play, all players and the public are invited for the 19th Hole Dinner, award presentation and a raffle drawing.

Awards and prizes will be presented to the first, second and third place overall teams. Prizes will also be awarded to the winners of the putting contest, the closest to the pin and longest drive contests.

Early Registration, by March 14 is \$125 per player, \$450 per team. Late Registration, after March 14 is \$150 per player, \$ 550 per team. Price includes cart, green fees, range balls, goody bag, lunch, beverages and ticket to 19th Hole Dinner.
