**JUNIOR LEAGUE OF ARLINGTON HOSTING 13th ANNUAL
“TEE IT UP FOR CHARITY” GOLF TOURNAMENT APRIL 10, 2015**

Arlington, Texas (March 4, 2015) - The Junior League of Arlington is hosting its Annual “Tee It Up For Charity” Golf Tournament on Friday, April 10, 2015. Proceeds from the event will be returned to the community through the projects and services of the Junior League of Arlington. This year’s tournament will be held at Walnut Creek Country Club, 1151 Country Club Drive in Mansfield, Texas. The tournament will be followed by dinner and a concert featuring 80s cover band, The Spazmatics.

The tournament will consist of a four-person, non-handicapped scramble beginning at 1:00 pm. Awards and prizes will be presented to the first place ladies’ team; to the first, second, and third place overall teams; and to winners of the closest to the pin, longest drive and hole-in-one contests. There will be activities and festivities throughout the day including 80s themed contests and a dinner and award presentation beginning at 6:30 p.m. followed by a concert on the driving range at 7:30 p.m.

“As the Junior League of Arlington celebrates our 40th year of service, we invite you to partner with us in building a better North Texas by attending our tournament and concert,” said Jeannie Deakyne, Junior League of Arlington President. “Comprised locally of 520 members, JLA has given over \$2 million and over one million volunteer hours to more than 100 agencies since 1975.”

Early Registration, by March 31, 2015, is \$160 per player. Late Registration, after March 31, 2015, is \$185 per player. Price includes cart, green fees, range balls, goody bag, dinner, beverages, and a ticket to the concert. Tickets may also be purchased for concert only at \$35 per person, which includes concert admission, dinner and two drinks.
